# Ryugakusei Musashino Family Program



This program was started in response to the requests of international students who hoped to have the opportunity to communicate with local people and in return wanted them to know more about their culture as well. The main activity is home visits for about 1 year. This program also includes events such as MIA exchange party, workshop, etc.

### **Program Content**

#### Description of activities

Principally this is a home visit program. MIA offer exchange events only for program participants.

#### Participating family

All of them are members of MIA. There are various families, such as large family, family consisting of one or two people. Some families are with small children, pets like dogs, cats and so on. It is precious opportunity to interact with people in various life style.

**Duration of the program** about 1 year Spring term: April - March Fall term: October– September

#### **Activity including expenses**

In principal you have to pay for your own expenses in such cases as excursions and trips with the family. We advice that you consult with your family about the expenses expected in activities.

#### Interaction events

#### (only for the program participants)

MIA holds interaction events for international students and family to understand each other well and enjoy together. The events are also good opportunity to know not only your family but also other family and international students.

### Procedure

#### **①Enrollment**

Students of Asia University, Seikei University, Tokyo University of Foreign Studies, Tokyo University of Agriculture and Engineering and Tokyo Woman's Christian University can submit an application form on MIA's website. Students of other universities should contact MIA first by email.

#### **②Introduction**

MIA will contact you by e-mail or telephone after designating your host family and notify when to come to MIA to meet your host family.

#### **3Visit**

You can contact your family freely to get together, meet or for anything else you may have planned. Please join MIA exchange events to promote mutual understanding.

#### Please keep the following rules.

①When your contact address/phone number has changed, please notify MIA and your family. ②When you are out of contact for a long time, such as you return to your home country for a certain period of time, please notify your family so as not to make them worry.

③Even though you were too busy to exchange with your family, please contact them when you leave Japan.

#### Q. What activities am I supposed to do?

A. It is important that both you and your family enjoy the time spent together and that neither of you feel stressed due to the activities. You may enjoy any of the activities at the rate of once a month, if you keep in mind the rules written on this brochure. When you are busy and unable to meet, you can communicate through LINE etc. Please make full use of free interaction events MIA holds.

#### Q. I do not like children/Pets. I cannot eat some foods. Can I join this pro gram?

A. We are going to choose you a family considering your request. We explain your restriction to your famiily in advance, please write in the application if you need special care.

## Q. If I have a question, or I am in trouble, who should I concat?

A. Please contact MIA. MIA offers legal and psy chological consultation with an interpreter too.
