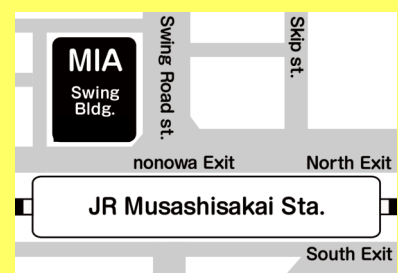

Communication support

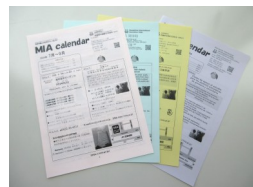
We provide necessary information for daily life in multiple languages.
