


SEP 1 is "防災の首" or National Disaster Prevention Day in Japan. Earthquakes and typhoons often hit Japan and they sometimes cause water stoppage or power outage. We should also note that roads may be damaged, and phones be disconnected then. No one can tell if and when earthquakes or typhoons hit us, so just be prepared.

- * It might be necessary for you to go to "ひなんじょ (*Hinanjo*: Evacuation Shelter)." Let's be prepared with "what you need at home" and "what you need to have in emergency backpack," and check them regularly from time to time.
- * "ひなんじょ" is the place where you go and stay in case your house is unlivable.







COVID-19 is still around us, and "ひなんじょ" or evacuation shelter is not risk-free with regard to spread of such infectious diseases. So, if your house is safe, you don't need to go to "ひなんじょ."

☆ You can buy "Disaster kits" at supermarkets and home centers.
