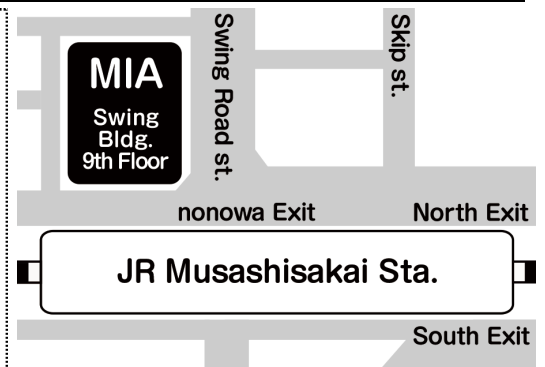

①Who are eligible for the benefit?

•Child-rearing households of low income, for children born from April 2, 2005 ~ February 29, 2024

\*Children with disabilities: From APR 2, 2003 ~ February 29, 2024

②How much is the benefit?

•It is 50,000 yen per child

☆Persons who are receiving it are not applicable; There are several requirements to be considered such as the following.

"Extent of sudden/big decrease of family budget," "exemption of residence tax" etc.
