# Child Care Information Magazine for 0 to 5 Years Old Children • MIA Special Editing Multilingual Version Creation Project

In recent years, even in Musashino City, childcare facilities have been increased, children's playgrounds have been created, and little by little environments for easy child-rearing have been established and movements to support child-rearing are becoming active.

However, some foreigners' fathers and mothers feel that it is difficult to obtain local childcare support information and utilize it for reasons such as Japanese language, the system is different and not well understood.

Therefore, in 2017, as the first step of such support of MIA, focusing on foreign volunteers who have experiences raising children in the area and currently supporting foreigners, we organized "Childcare Information Magazine MIA Special Editing Multilingual Version Creation Project" and based on "The Child Rearing Information Magazine Sukusuku" issued by Musashino City, we edited and added information for foreigners and translated it to English version, Chinese version and Korean version. And this time, with the cooperation of Musashino City, we were able to update the MIA edition to the latest information and create Chinese, English and Korean versions.

MIA will continue to improve access to information for foreigners and help them make the most of it.

**Japanese Course with Childcare**: Thursday and Friday morning, 3 terms per year (10 times per term).

Interpreter dispatch • Translation Service: Basically 5,000 yen within 2 hours. MIA registered and trained language volunteers will interpret at City Hall counter, City Facilities such as daycare centers and schools, etc. Please sign up in advance for schedule arrangement. (Twice a free campaign during the year is in progress.)

The Multiple Language Window for Questions: Assisting in living such as living consultation arrangements, reading a newsletters from the school and interpreting at MIA, etc.

## Experiences of Senior Mom

There were such good things when participating in MIA's Japanese-language course with childcare.

•Because my child was taken care of by the volunteer staff, I was able to study Japanese at ease.

(Because there is no child) I was able to be alone and relax.

- •I made friends. After class, we had lunch together and went to the park to have fun.
- •I heard a lot of stories of the kindergarten from senior mothers. Is it a lunch box? Is there a school lunch? Do you make your own picture book bag? Is there a custody childcare? I listened to lots of things and they taught me.
- •I was taught the place where children play.
- "Where is the cheap and enjoyable place?" "Park (Koen) is good"
- "XX pool is fun too" "Go to  $\triangle \Delta$  amusement park (Yu-enchi)", etc.
- •I sang Japanese child songs together.
- •My child learned Japanese greetings. (Hello, goodbye, thank you ...)

#### I used MIA Interpreter Dispatch.

MIA volunteers will help interpretation at Musashino City Hall counter, daycare centers, schools, etc. to help with language problems.

I used this support to talk with my child's teacher. Once a month, we interviewed at the daycare center. The teacher told me how she was doing, who she was playing with and what she ate for lunch. The teacher also gave me helpful advice. Thanks to the interpreter, I was able to understand the teacher's story without any problems and to communicate. I also had plenty of time to ask questions, so I was able to clear up the worries after the interview.

This service is charged, but I think it's worth it.

Interpretation services are available when you come to Health Center or when a public health nurse visits your home. Please contact us in advance.

#### When you become pregnant

Please receive a doctor's diagnosis as soon as possible and submit a **Pregnancy Notification Form** to the **Health Section (Health Center)**. We will issue **Mother and Child Health Handbook** and **Pregnant Women's Health Checkup Examination Forms** so that we can record the health status of mothers and babies and receive free medical examination and free vaccination service.

- ★If you visit a medical institution outside of Tokyo (only in Japan) for reasons such as Satogaeri (to go home and give birth), or if you are pregnant with multiples and have had more than 15 prenatal health checkups, you can apply for a subsidy from the city.

#### Yurikago Musashi interview

A full-time public health nurse will conduct an interview with Yurikago Musashi (reservation required) and answer various questions and concerns during pregnancy. Pregnant women who have moved in should also make a reservation for the interview with Yurikago Musashi.

- ★ Pregnant women who have been interviewed will be given a child/child-rearing support ticket (child gift certificate: worth 10,000 yen).
- ★ Childbirth support gift (equivalent to 50,000 yen) eligible (see P.21)

#### Consultation on pregnancy and childbirth (Health Center)

Public health nurses will answer various questions and concerns about pregnancy and childbirth by telephone or interview.

#### Pre/Post Birth Helpers Business

Pregnant women who have obtained a Maternal and Child Health Handbook and women who have given birth less than 6 months (in the case of multiple births, less than 3 years since the date of delivery) (both residents of the city) cannot receive help with housework and childcare from their families during the day, helpers help with household chores.

#### When your baby is born

#### **Birth Registration**

Please notify the municipal office of parent's legal domicile, the address of the parents (including the place of temporary residence), or the place of birth within 14 days (including the date of birth) from the day the child was born.

#### Hello Baby Visit

All households that have babies until 4 months after birth

When your child is born, please apply using the 2D barcode on the Maternal and Child Health Handbook (Birth Notification Sheet). At a later date, we will adjust the schedule and a nurse / midwife will visit to take baby's weight measurement and child - rearing consultation.

#### Postpartum care business

Mothers and babies less than one year after giving birth are eligible. This is a business where mothers can receive care from midwives and other experts and receive advice on breastfeeding, etc., and can take a break. Please check the website for details.

## Gokkun Class, Mogu Mogu Class, Kamikami Class, Class for one year old (Health Center)

Priority is given to parents who are parenting for the first time. There is a classroom at Health Center according to the age of the baby, such as talk about baby food and about cleaning of teeth.

## About Vaccination

- We carry out individual inoculation in city designated medical institution.
- When vaccinating, "Preliminary Examination Form" and "Mother and Child Health Handbook" are necessary.
- The "Preliminary Examination Form" and the "list of medical institutions" that can receive vaccinations for free will be sent separately at the beginning of vaccination (see notification period in the table).
- For those who do not have "Preliminary Examination Form" by transfer, or those who lost it, please bring "Mother and Child Health Handbook" to the Health Section (Health Center).
- You can inoculate "until" and "less than" until the day before your birthday.
- For vaccines to vaccinate over 9 years old, please check on Health News / City Website, etc.

## **Experiences of Senior Mom**

#### I used Mother and Child Handbook (Mother and Child Health Handbook)!

•When I knew my pregnancy and had Mother and Child Handbook issued at the Health Section (Health Center), I was told "Congratulations!" I realized that "I'm going to be a mother!"

#### Good Points about Mother and Child Handbook

- •By making notes of what I noticed during pregnancy, it became a bridge between me and the obstetrician doctor, and since my baby was born it became a child-care diary by writing down what happened to my baby.
- •The record of changes in my body during pregnancy remained. I could record the date of my first pregnancy checkup and the day when I felt fetal movement. I thought it was good to have this record when I looked back several years later.
- •I will not forget the weight of the child at birth even if the child grows up, but I forget the weight at the age of months. However, I have a record of medical examination in Mother and Child Handbook so I was able to look back on later.
- •There is a spare column on the last page of Mother and Child Handbook. Because my child had food allergies, I was recording when and what kind of symptoms appeared while eating. Even when the doctor suddenly asked about allergic symptoms at the hospital, I was able to answer concretely when I saw Mother and Child Handbook.

#### Baby Health Examination (Health Examination)

- •A questionnaire form for a baby to receive medical examination for free was sent from Musashino city at the time of visit.
- •I was nervous about my baby's first medical examination, but since baby's developmental guideline was written in Mother and Child Handbook, so I was able to receive it with a little peace of mind.
- •I consulted with the teacher what I am worried about and anxious about at the time of medical examination.

It was a good time to be relieved of parent's feelings.

•There was a sitting check of the neck at the health examination for 3-4 months, and my child was re-examined again. But I was able to notice this because they pointed out at that exam.

#### Baby got a vaccination

- "Vaccination Preliminary Examination Form" that can receive vaccinations for free was sent from Musashino city at the time of inoculation started.
- •When receiving vaccination, I brought this "Vaccination Preliminary Examination Form" and Mother and Child Handbook. Hospital people recorded which vaccinations were received in Mother and Child Handbook. There were times when it was necessary to check vaccination since entering elementary school, but I understood it immediately by looking at Mother and Child Handbook.
- •I thought many times that my child was sore and pity. But I did not want to regret that if my child got a big sickness because of not taking the vaccination at that time. So, I received all the vaccinations that were decided. For children, I think that it is better to receive vaccination for the future of children.

# 2. A circle of support that supports you "Children and Families Center"

Children and Families Center \*(Children and Families Support Center, Health Center (Health Section)) and local child care counselling organizations (0123 Kichijoji, 0123 Harappa, and Sakurazutsumi Children's Center) total 5 centers work together to provide support in the community from the pregnancy period.

If it is related to children and child care, ask staff for any consultation. After listening to your story, if there is an appropriate referral, the staff will connect you to the staff.

\*Children and Families Center is a general term for consultation support related to children and child care.



Matters related to pregnancy and childbirth and life with the baby, regarding the health of children in infancy, public health nurses, registered dietitians, dental hygienists, midwives, etc. work together to provide continuous support, mainly for maternal and child health projects such as infant health checkups and childcare consultations.







Sum of the subsidy amount [1,800 to 6,200 yen (maximum monthly amount)] determined by the Tokyo Metropolitan Government according to the income of the guardian (based on the income of the municipal tax) and the subsidy amount [4,000 yen (maximum monthly amount)] determined by the city, and issue it (total 5,800 yen  $\sim$ ).

■ Support for the use of various group activity projects for children before entering elementary school

A portion of the usage fee will be subsidized for parents of children who use group activities that meet the standards set by the city.

Grant amount: 20,000 yen per month

## Childcare Facility Q&A

- Q1 What is the difference between Daycare Center and Kindergarten?
- A. The Daycare Center entry criterion is that parents are working there are reasons that require childcare, such as being sick. Kindergarten is for children from 3 years old, and you can enroll even if there is no reason to require childcare.
- Q2 Where do I get the admission application documents?
- A. We distribute "Handbook of Childcare Facility" and admission application documents at Ninka Certified Childcare Facilities, Municipal Administration Centers, Child Raising Support Section, etc.
- \*The Child Raising Support Section also distributes an English version of the admission application documents.
- Q3 Can I join in the middle of the fiscal year?
- A. Application for admission is accepted from the 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> of the month before the month you wish to join, and you can enter if there is a seat. (There is no admission in February or March.) Please consult the Child Development Section.

As for the acceptance of entry in April, we will inform you on the city newsletter "Shiho Musashino" and Website.

- Q4 Can I enter a childcare facility even while I am in a job offer?
- A. It is conditional to have a job within 3 months after entry. Please contact each facility for Non-Ninka Certified Daycare Facilities.
- Q5 What is the entrance fee and the user's burden?
- A. There is no admission fee in the case of Ninka Certified Daycare Facilities in the city. There is no difference between the municipal and the private sector for the user's burden, and it is decided by the citizen tax income dividend of the parent. There is a mitigation measure after the second child. In the case of Non-Ninka Certified Daycare Facilities, please contact them as it varies from facility to facility.

#### ■Kindergarten Q&A

- Q1 Can I visit the kindergarten before entering?
- A. If you wish to visit, please contact in advance by phone, etc. before you go. Also, there are kindergartens conducting kindergarten recruitment briefings and kindergarten visits, so please contact each kindergarten.
- Q2 How do I get an entry application form?
- A. The entry application form for the following fiscal year will be distributed in each kindergarten from around 15th October. For details, please see the September 15 the issue Shiho-Musashino.
- **Q 3** Tell me about the entrance procedure.
- A . Please bring an application form for admission directly to each kindergarten. Regarding the interview at the time of admission and the decision on acceptance or rejection, there is a kindergarten to do on the designated day different from the kindergarten to be done on the submission date of the application form for admission. Regarding admission fee and facility maintenance fee, it seems that there are many cases where you pay mostly within one week after the admission decision.
- Q4 Can I enter in the middle of the fiscal year?
- A. Some kindergarten might be accepting entrance even during the year, please contact the kindergarten directly.
- Q5 How much is the child care fee?
- A. It depends on the kindergarten. It is roughly 25,000 yen to 35,000 yen per month. By making early childhood education free, you can receive free benefits up to the free upper limit. About kindergarten which shifted to new system, childcare charges become free in full.
- Q6 What is the subsidy system for nursery fees, etc.?
- A. For children who attend private kindergartens, we will grant subsidies from Musashino City. (For kindergartens in and outside the city) Application will be distributed from each kindergarten after entering. Please submit the submission to the city office by mail or directly to the city hall (We do not handle at the municipal administration center). Please refer to P.24 for details of subsidy, amount of money, etc.
- Q7 Are there events for pre-kindergarten children?
- A . In kindergartens, we utilize the special characteristics of each kindergarten, and we are carrying out events that allow parents and pre-kindergarten children to participate. Please use as a place to make friends and group play experience. For details, please refer to the Shiho Musashino or Website.

## **Experiences of Senior Mom**

As I was going back to work after childbirth and child rearing, I had to find a facility where I could leave my 2 years old child to be taken care of. Since I had no information on Japanese childcare facilities, I went directly to the city office and asked various questions. It was very helpful because they explained from the general thing of the application for admission to small details kindly. Since the application period for all entrance ceremonies from April in the following year was from November, I made preparations for preparing the documents and visiting daycares so as to make it in time. Many of my friends started 'Hokatsu' (the activity performed by parents to put their children in daycare) from September and October. Fortunately, the entrance from April was decided and I was able to go back to work at ease.

Japanese daycare (Ninka Certified Daycare Center) is a facility that keeps children and keeps them when parents are working or are in a state of sickness, when childcare at home is difficult. People who wish to enter daycare can only enter unless they meet the admission conditions. Since the acceptance period of the entrance application is different for April and the others, it is necessary to prepare for application in according to the desired time of entrance. The reception of the entrance in April of the following year will start around November. Gather information positively by going to the city office or ask directly to the daycare, to check such as early to meet the entrance criteria and which daycare meets our child.

If the applicant for admission exceeds the capacity, the numerical value used for screening is called "index". A person with a high index can preferentially enter the daycare. Although the method of calculating the index varies depending on the municipality, it seems that you can score high and take a high index, such as when working hour are long. It is quite difficult to enter the desired daycare if it is not possible to obtain a high index for reasons such as short working hours. If the child is over 3 years old, in such cases it is also a way to enter a kindergarten where has a substantial child care (it is also called 'extended childcare' which child care for hours after the regular hours). Basically, conditions for entering kindergarten are not except for age. However, if the number of entrants wishing to enroll exceeds the capacity, you may fall by interview, so let's prepare with multiple kindergartens as candidates. \* Please ask Child raising Support Section (0422-60-1854) for the latest information of children on the waiting list.

Musashino City Hall has counselor Nursery Concierge. We receive consultation from each family and provide information on the childcare service that matches the circumstances and hope of the family. If you are having trouble finding children's childcare facilities, you may also consult an expert to help them. Consultation will be in Japanese, so you can also use Interpreter Dispatch of MIA (chargeable/Free for twice during the fiscal year).

## Pre/post Birth Helpers

We send a helper to families with pregnant women who are having difficulty to do housework and parenting due to poor physical condition before and after childbirth, to support life.

Applicant: A pregnant woman who has Mother and Child Health Handbook. A maternal woman within 6 months from the day of birth (within three years from the day of birth in the case of multiple). (Those who live in the city and who need assistance from being unable to receive housekeeping / parenting assistance from families, etc.)

Usage limit: 80 hours (In the case of multiple births, 120 hours from the day the Mother and Child Health Handbook is obtained until the day before the child's 1st birthday, and 120 hours per year thereafter.)

Utilization time: 4 hours a day in units of 1 hour out of 8:00 am to 7:00 pm (excluding New Year's holidays)

## Experiences of the Senior Mom

We also used temporary childcare!

#### •I used the child rearing support of an NPO Corporation

• At the age of 2, my son became atopic dermatitis. At night, he could not sleep because it was so itchy that I had to dandle him and I always didn't get enough sleep. My husband and I are both far away from home, so there is no help. I was always irritated because my daily sleep deprivation and my son's atopic dermatitis did not get better. When consulting at the medical examination, I was introduced to NPO Corporations that are providing child rearing support. At first, I was very worried about having a stranger who I do not know taking care of my son.

However, the person who came was a very nice person and my intensely shy son was enough to make it familiar on the day. There were only people experiencing child rearing, I was able to leave it with peace of mind. They went out together and when he came home he seemed even cuter.

I was relieved from the first time childcare and I was able to relax and it helped me a lot. Even now, I remember nostalgically about those who took care of my son those days. For children, for Dad and Mom, I think I can spend my daily life more enjoyable by using temporary childcare.

#### •I used Daycare for children with Sickness or Post-Sickness

I usually have my son kept at the daycare, but he sometimes gets sick (a fever, etc.), and be absent from the daycare. Although the fever fell, I am still worried to let him play in the daycare. In such cases, I was able to take my child at a post-sickness childcare facility with a nurse, and I was able to work with peace of mind. It is better to register before the child gets sick.

#### •I used Pre/Post Birth Helpers System

• During pregnancy, I was diagnosed as a pre-placenta and was told to rest quietly in bed from my doctor. However, because I had a 2 years old boy who still love to play outside, I could not sleep at home all day.

At that time, I learned about Pre/Post Birth Helpers System, and the Helper took my son to play outside in the morning. Thanks to that, I got some time to lie down.

• It was when I gave birth to the third child. The second child was still a kindergarten child and needed to be picked up and dropped off every day. I could not bring out the newborn baby outside so I asked the helper to pick up and drop off to the kindergarten. It was particularly grateful, especially on rainy days.
