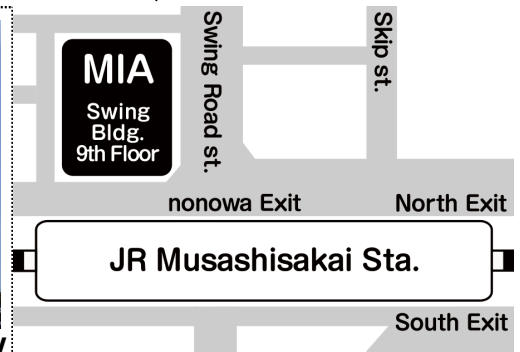



●After using the **North exit**, head left for 1 min.; or if you use the **nonowa exit**, it's just across the street on your right!
